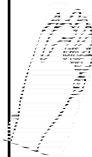
The Sanctuary Light: This week the lights burn for special intentions.

Dear Parish Family,

We all know the results of massive amounts of rainfall and have experienced flooding here in Austin County this year. What has happened in Louisiana is much worse. As many as 60,000 homes have been damaged and nearly 20,000 people have been rescued or evacuated. Cardinal DiNardo has written in his letter to the parishes of our Archdiocese:

"Lives have become completely altered. As a people of God, let us come to their aid. I encourage parishioners across Galveston-Houston to respond generously. Our prayer and material support is urgently needed to help rebuild lives. Our hearts and prayers go out to loved ones and all those living in communities who have lost homes and businesses along with their sense of security."

Here at Immaculate Conception, we will be receiving funds all during the month of September for Louisiana flood victims. They will be available by the St. Joseph Statue in the Church entry way and can be placed into any collection during September or brought to the office.

Querida familia parroquial, Todos conocemos los resultados de las cantidades masivas de lluvia que cayeron en el condado de Austin este año. Lo que ha pasado en Luisiana es mucho peor. 60,000 casas han sido dañadas por las lluvias y 20,000 personas fueron rescatadas o evacuadas. El Cardenal DiNardo ha escrito en su carta a las parroquias de nuestra Archidiócesis lo siguiente: "Vidas han cambiado completamente. Como la gente de Dios, debemos ayudarlos.
